Face to Face Interview Questions

- How long have you been in business and why home care
- Are the people providing the care employees of your company
- What are your recruitment practices
- What screenings are performed before the applicant is hired
- What insurance do you carry
- How do you decide who will provide the care; Same person each visit
- How far in advance do I need to schedule a service
- Do I have to sign a contract
