- Helped one another w/in FVOP with grant proposals to continue the missions.

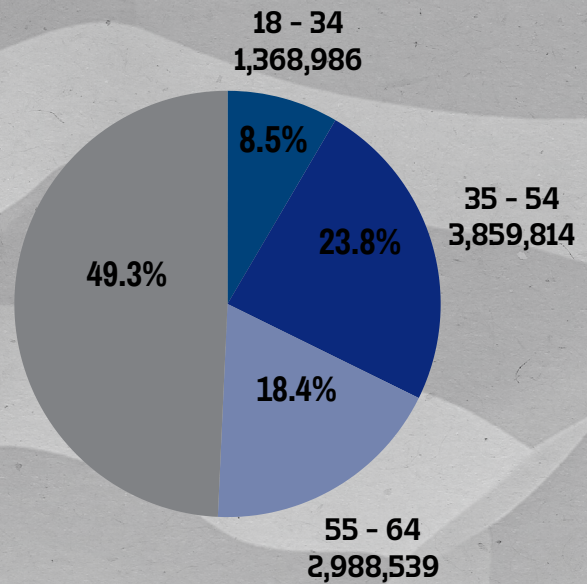


## WHO ARE THE VETERANS?

Too often we do not realize the impact we have on certain groups of people. The majority of US Veterans also overlap those at the age of retirement and within our Senior Citizen population.

The statistics represent the Veteran data as of 2022. During 2024, the US Census Bureau estimates 11 to 12 thousand Americans will turn 65 years old each day (approximately 4.4 million in 2024).
